The purpose of this synopsis is to gain knowledge of interest, capabilities, and qualifications of various members of the private development industry. The type of acquisition to be issued will depend upon the responses received to this synopsis.

This is a sources-sought announcement; a market survey to solicit developer interest from the private sector, to be used for preliminary planning purposes. This is not a formal request for proposals, and no contract will be directly awarded from this synopsis; however, the City may select a developer or developers to enter into negotiations to develop and implement selected development plans best suited for the Downtown Marina in Panama City. No reimbursement will be made for any costs associated with providing information in response to this synopsis or any follow-up information requests.

A submission in response to this solicitation should be a document and/or web site proposal detailing the project scope, project plans, facilities, project financing agreements, roles and commitment for each party to the partnership, incentives and resources committed by each party to the agreement, and project schedule.

The City reserves the right to evaluate, score, select, and determine at its sole discretion the proposals and/or partnership arrangements that best suit the vision, goals, and direction of the City.
