CRA Profile

 Florida CRAs generated \$716 million in total revenues in FY2007-2008

- Total revenues exceeded total expenditures by approximately 30 percent
- Total revenues exceeded total expenditures in all regions of the State and in all population sizes of CRA municipalities

 Preliminary CRA sample analysis shows steady growth in TIF, total revenues and taxable values for FYS 2002-2007

 Florida CRAs effective in securing additional non-TIF resources including Federal EDA Funds, LIHTCs, and HUD-NSP Funds
