

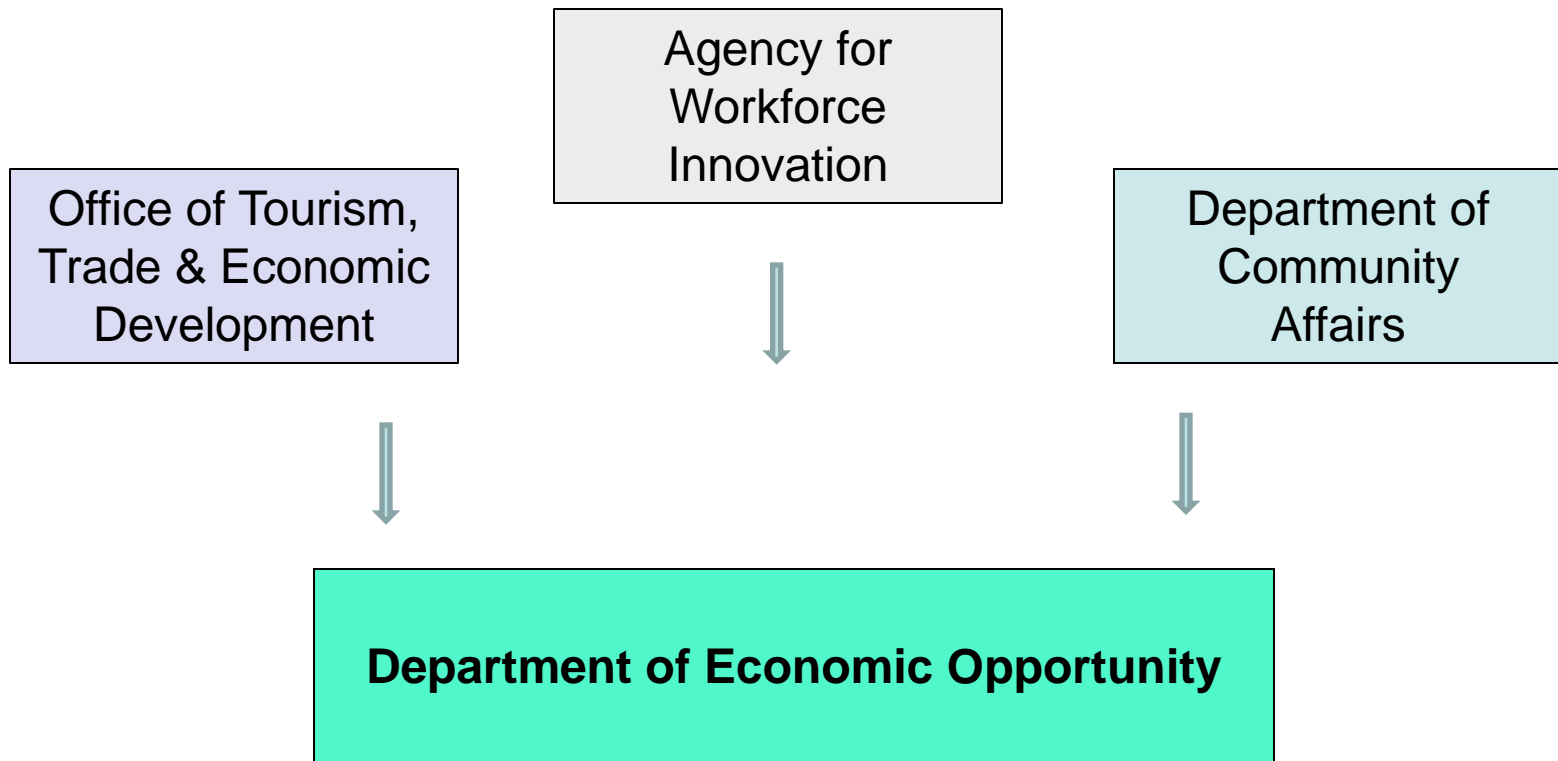
Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO)

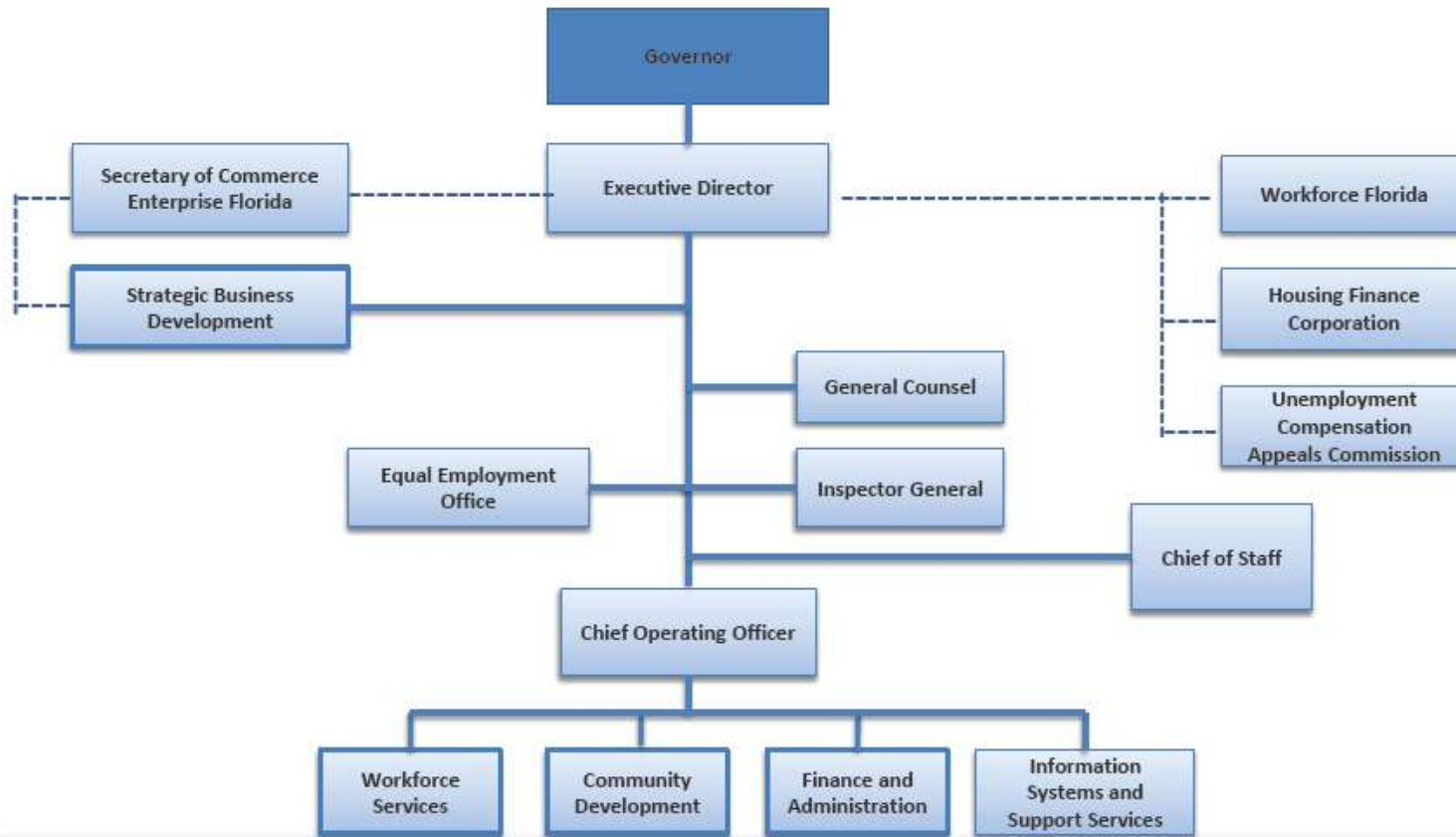

Divisions created with defined responsibilities:

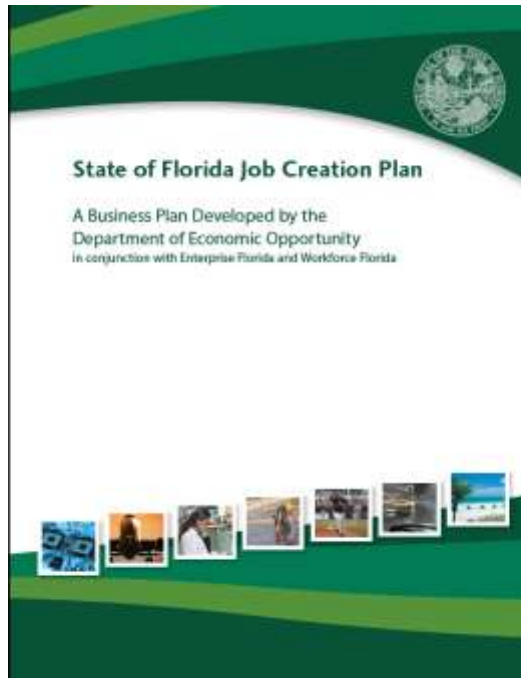
1. Division of Strategic Business Development.
