Racial Characteristics:

Of the people living in this area in between 2011-2015, **59.66**% are White, **27.21**% are African American, **37.09**% are Hispanic, **0.44**% are Asian, **0**% are either Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, **0**% are American Indian or Alaskan Native, **12.2**% are of "some other race" and **0.48**% are of two or more races. In the table below, the percentage of the population that each segment represents in the report area is compared to the

Incomes:

The median household income for the study area **ranged from \$26,573 to \$40,653**, compared to the state of Florida with a median of **\$47,507**, as estimated for 2011-2015 by the Census' American Community Survey.

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2011-2015 indicate that **944** people or **15.43**% of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Tenure:
