One Problem: Pilot Shortage

• As Bloomberg has reported, studies from top aviation departments in the United States predict that by 2026, the pilot deficit could be as big as 15,000.

#### One explanation:

 Mandatory retirement age for pilots, as mandated by the Federal Aviation Administration, is 65 years old.

#### One Solution:

• An opportunity for future pilots

Today, average pilot salary is around \$80,000.00 and the highest earners can make as much as \$200,000.00.

Class Project Unmanned Aircraft Systems
Robotics



This course prepares students to integrate robotic technology into the hardware and software regimes of unmanned aviation. It will include examinations of control and system programming in the context of specific missions through guided discussions, simulation, and the operation of actual unmanned aircraft robotic systems.

Class Fieldtrip Private Pilot Operations



This course develops the aeronautical knowledge required for certification as a Private Pilot with an Airplane Single Engine Land rating. Topics include: regulations, safety, pre-solo operations, cross-country planning, airspace, chart use, communications, weather, performance, weight and balance, aerodynamics, and decision-making.

#### Outcome

A demographic typically underrepresented in Aviation Aerospace, now has the opportunity to consider this career field. The only senior year student in the Program for the 2016-2017 school year was accepted into Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University with a \$17,000 scholarship!
