









The NW 31 Avenue Corridor has been part of community planning initiatives for over a decade. This road is surrounded by schools, multi-family homes, park facilities and greenway trails that generate high pedestrian and vehicular traffic.



At various interactive public outreach meetings, maps and illustrative renderings have been utilized to assess roadway conditions, address public concerns and develop strategies to revitalize NW 31 Avenue.

Through a successful collaboration with several agencies, the Northwest 31 Corridor Improvement Project addresses a $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile roadway issues that impact a regional roadway network. The transformation of NW 31 Avenue is illustrated below. (Before and After)
