Project Phases



Phase I

Design and construction of enhancements to the bridge façade, tender house, Jersey barriers, system lighting, etc. The design/build team were responsible for design, permitting and coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

Phase II

Included larger aesthetic design elements such as four large tensioned sails at each quadrant of the bridge, computerized up-lighting, nautical artwork on bridge facades and land-based lighting.

Phase III

A pedestrian Waterfront Promenade under the bridge connecting restaurants and buildings from south to north and the construction of a sidewalk that will be known as the "Trailway to the Waterway."

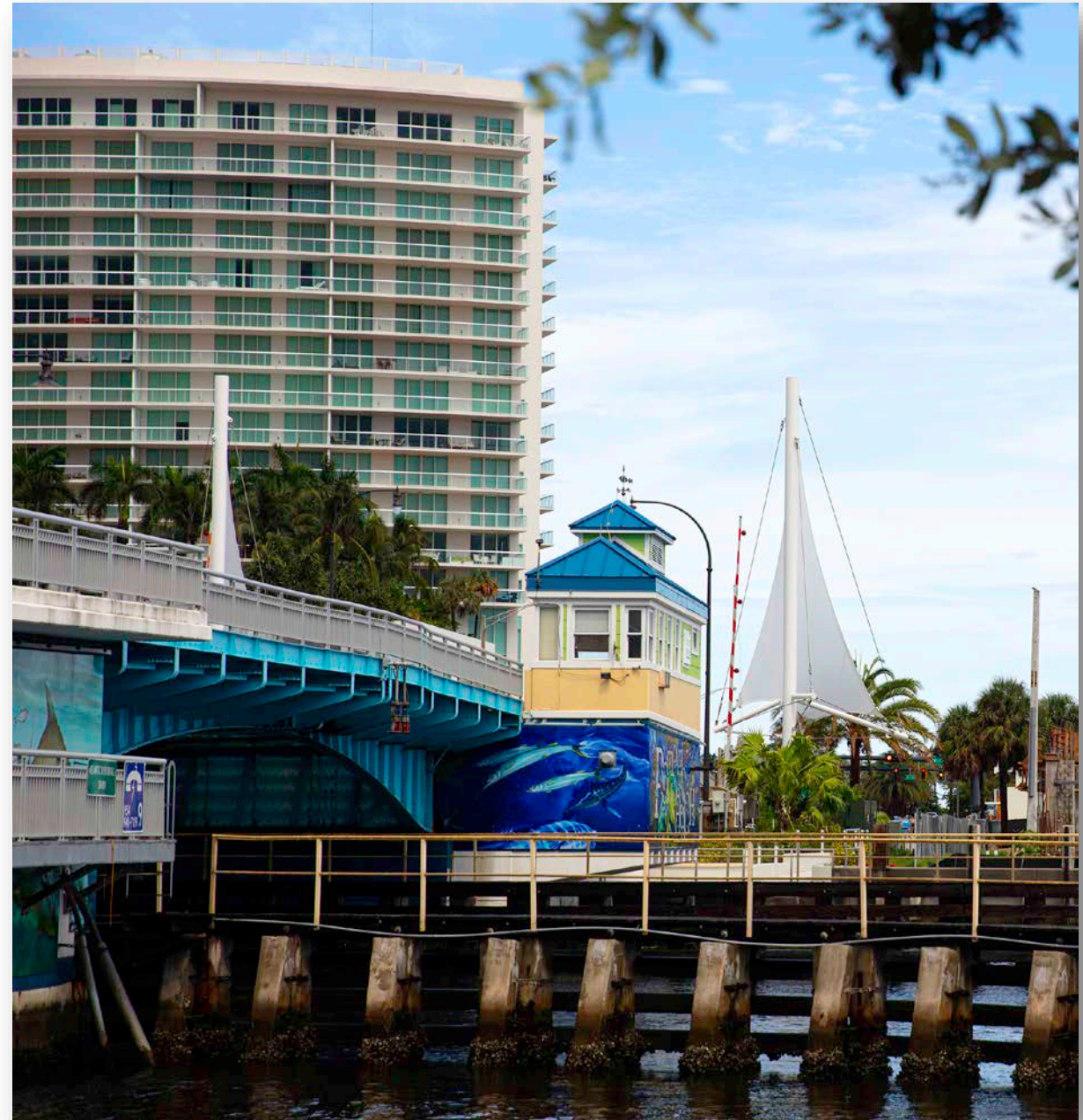
