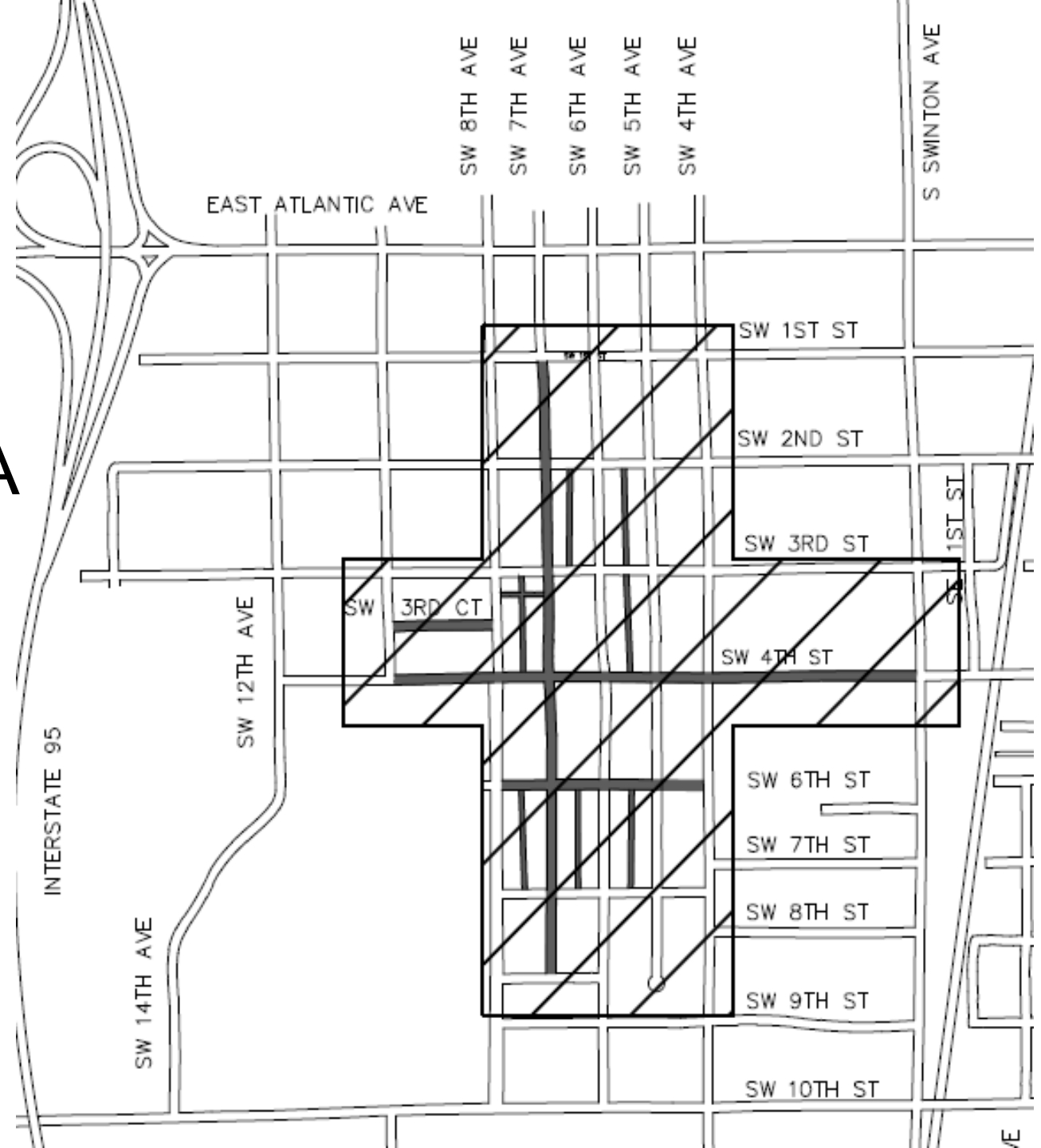

Project Objectives

- 1.6 miles of roadway resurfacing or reconstruction
- 1.0 miles of construction new permeable pavement alleyways
- Rehabilitation of the existing potable water, sanitary and storm sewer systems
- Improve area drainage and landscaped parkways
- Improve landscaping
- Install reclaimed water main improvements
- Improve sidewalk deficiencies (fill in gaps and replace trip hazards) meeting ADA standards
- Improve the area's street lighting (LED) along the roadways in the project area and add lighting (LED) along the alleys in the project area
- Relocation of existing power poles as needed.

Project Impacts to the Community

- 7 New pervious and transitable alleyways
- 22 Roadway sections improved
- Water Main improvements
- Dozens of new LED lights poles
- More sidewalks and ADA features
- More landscaping and green areas
- Traffic calming features
- Updated water, sanitary, and storm water systems

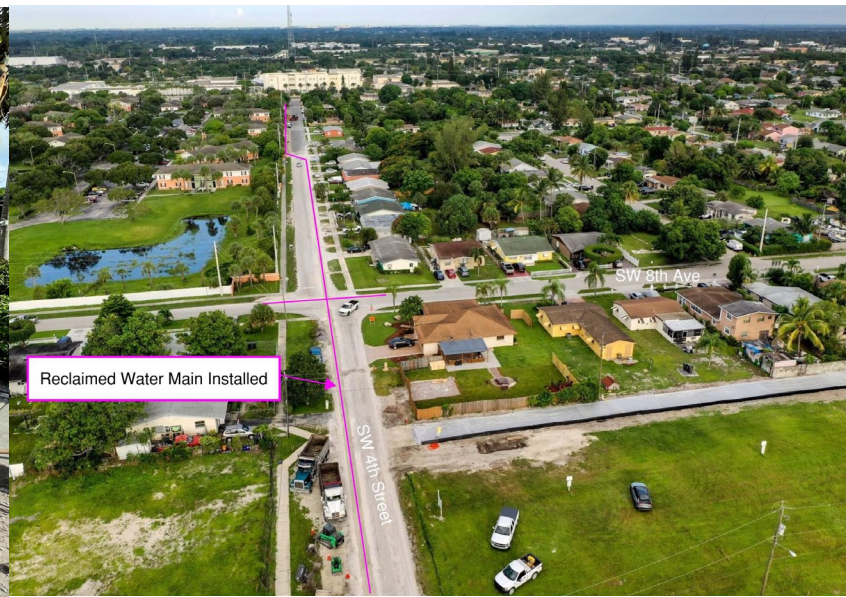

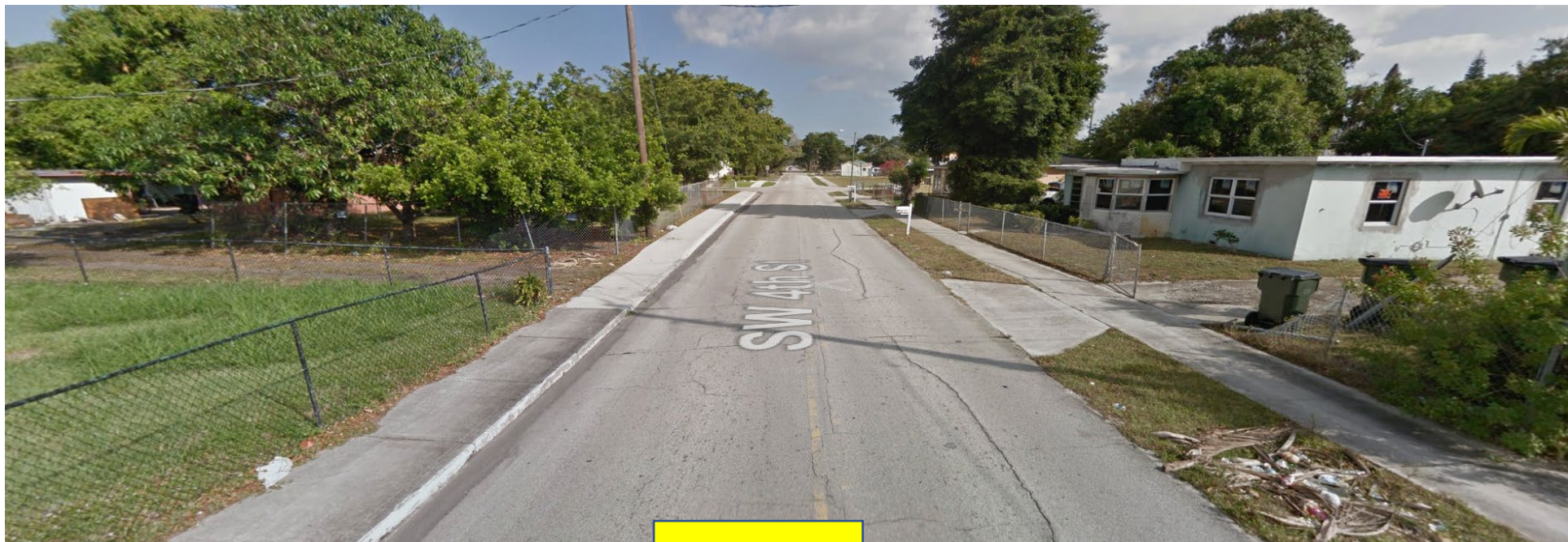
